#### What is the Pitch Corner?

The Pitch Corner is a unique space, right at the heart of the event, where project leaders can present their project for 15 minutes as part of the Climate Chance Europe Africa 2025 Summit taking place in Marseille, Palais du Pharo, on 31 March and 1 April.







#### What are the criteria for applying?

- Be a non-state actor: local authorities and communities, businesses, associations, trade unions, professional federations, non-governmental organisations, scientific bodies, donors, citizens committed to climate action in Europe or Africa, youth and women's organisations, farmers' organisations.
- Carrying out a project whose actions take place in Europe of Africa.
- Have an ongoing project on one of the following themes, related to adaptation to climate change:
  - Agriculture Food
  - Biodiversity Forestry Land use
  - Water
  - Education Training
  - Renewable energy
  - Climate financing

- International cooperation
- Housing Sustainable construction
- Mobility Sustainable transport
- · Oceans Coastline
- Planning Regional development Sustainable cities
- Multi-level governance

Particular attention is paid to innovative and replicable projects
